Unopposed Motion to Extend Sentencing Date

The United States respectfully submits this unopposed motion requesting that this Court extend the date for sentencing in this matter to allow the defendant to continue to provide cooperation pursuant to the plea agreement entered April 1, 2004.

On April 1, 2004, the defendant entered a plea of guilty to a single count information charging a violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1924. Pursuant to that agreement, the defendant has agreed to continue to cooperate with the government in its investigation of matters related to the defendant's conduct at the National Archives. That cooperation includes meeting with the Inspector General of the National Archives. Defendant's cooperation is ongoing, and the government needs the additional time to allow for full and complete cooperation. We respectfully request that a sentencing date be set for August 24, 2005, approximately a one and one half month extension.

The defendant has no objection to this motion nor the proposed date for sentencing.
